

Privacy Policy

This Privacy policy agreement (this “**Policy**” or “**Policy Agreement**”) shall govern the sale of XBXCOIN (“**XBX**”) issued and administered by XBX Global Limited, a corporation incorporated under the laws of British Virgin Islands with registered office at Intershore Chambers, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands, hereinafter shall be referred to as (“**XBX Global Limited**”) (“**we**”, “**us**” and “**our**”) to the Purchasers of XBX (“**Purchasers**” collectively, and “**Purchaser**” individually and/or “**Users**” collectively, and “**User**” individually), The Initial Coin Offering (“**ICO**”) shall commence on 1st August, 2021 and the Public Listing of XBX shall commence on September – October, 2021 and onwards on major cryptocurrency exchanges across the world, or after the specific, allocated amount of the issued XBX as announced prior to official ICO date are sold off .The company reserves the right to change, amend or postpone the date of Initial Coin Offering, extend, or reduce the commencing date and/or duration of the ICO or Public Trading Day arising under any unexpected circumstances or Force Majeure which the company shall inform Purchasers on its official websites, social media promptly as possible.

Any materials provided in the relation of the XBX do not constitute a prospectus of any sort, is not a solicitation for investment and does not pertain in any way to an offering of securities or collectively investment scheme in any jurisdiction. Neither this document nor any other materials have been (or will be) or capable of being registered as a prospectus with any governmental authorities.

To the extent necessary, consultancy of an appropriate lawyer, accountant, or tax professional, prior to contributing, Purchasers agree to carefully consider the policy and all other materials available concerning XBX.

Introduction

The designated Initial Coin Offering shall be participated through third party’s websites. The purpose of this Policy agreement is to inform you of how we will process your personal data as data controllers and the measures and processes we have put in place to ensure its adequate protection. We value the privacy of our customers and site visitors and thus, it is significant for you to understand our Privacy Policy. This Policy agreement does not form any contractual relationship between you and us, and we may amend it from time to time.

User Consent

We collect information about you in a range of forms, including personal data. As used in this Policy, “personal data” means data that allows someone to identify or contact you, including, for example, your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, as well as any other non-public information about you that is associated with or linked to any of the foregoing data. We will only process your personal data in accordance with applicable data protection and privacy laws. We need certain personal data to provide you with access to our services.

We will only process your personal data:

- (a) where you have given your consent;
- (b) where the processing is necessary to provide our services to you;
- (c) where the processing is necessary to respond to a request from you;
- (d) where the processing is necessary to maintain your account with us; and

(e) where the processing is necessary for compliance with our legal and regulatory obligations

In case of (a) above, you may withdraw your consent at any time, by making a request as set out below:

The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. If you do not agree to our use of your personal data in line with this Policy, please do not use our services.

A note about children

We do not intentionally gather personal data from visitors who are under the age of 18. If a child under 18 submits personal data to Company and we learn that the personal data is the information of a child under 18, we will attempt to delete the information as soon as possible. How we collect your personal data

Information you provide to us

We usually collect your personal data from the information you submit during the course of your relationship with us. This will typically be through you registering or subscribing for one of our services, placing an order, accessing and using our online services, clicking on an advert that we put on our or someone else's website, asking for information or assistance, giving us feedback, or filling in surveys. However, we may combine your personal data with information we collect from other users in an aggregate and anonymous format and sell or provide this anonymous data and analytics about our customers and site visitors to third parties.
